\$180,000 NROTC SCHOLARSHIP MARINE OPTION



Basic Eligibility

- Be a U.S. Citizen
- Be at least 17 years of age and not older than 23 by 1 September of the year you start college
- Must be within Marine Corps height, weight, and body fat standards
- Must score a 200/300 on a Marine Corps Physical Fitness Test
- Take the ACT, SAT, or AFQT prior to scholarship submission deadline, and meet the minimum scores below:
 - SAT: 1000 Math and CR
 - ACT: 22 Composite
 - AFQT: 74
