- Are currently enrolled in a high school located in Northeast Ohio
- Will graduate from high school at the end of the 2022 academic year
- Plan to enroll in college as a full-time student in 2022-2023

Emphasis will be placed on the ability to clearly articulate academic and career goals, students who are the first or second generation in their family to attend college, service to the community, maturity and motivation.

(Student-athletes are welcome to participate; however, this is not a per-requisite for applying.)

- Semi-finalists will be asked to participate in an individual interview at the College Now Greater Cleveland Resource Center.
- Finalists may be asked to participate in a second interview with location to be disclosed at a later date.
- Selected Recipients must attend a December 2021 Cleveland Browns presentation/announcement event (at a Browns home game or virtual celebration) [contingent upon 2021 National Football League's and the Cleveland Brown's protocols and requirements]
- Selected recipients must be willing to send regular updates to College Now Greater Cleveland and Cleveland Browns on academic status.
- Selected recipients must be willing to share personal stories.
- Selected recipients must be willing to participate in media interviews; verbal, video and photos.

THE FOLLOWING MATERIALS ARE REQUIRED TO APPLY:

- Applications must be submitted Online.

- Official copy of high school transcript showing cumulative grade point average through the end of junior year (Note: senior year grades will be required before final selections are made)
- Copy of SAT or ACT scores (Note: scores on an official high school transcript are acceptable, but copies of the report from the testing agency are preferred). (Only test scores through September 2021 will be accepted)
- Essays (two are required; questions on application)
- Extracurricular resume or list of activities
- Letter of recommendation from a teacher or guidance counselor who know you well
- Semifinalists will be required to provide copies of their parents' 2020 tax returns
