The Quota Club of Lake County has \$1,000 available each year to be awarded to a student to assist in a special way. This \$1,000 is offered through the Janice Southworth Memorial Scholarship Fund. It is available to any resident of Lake County who plans to pursue study in the fields of speech, hearing, visual impairment, physical therapy, social work, elementary or secondary education. Those pursuing education in an ancillary field where children are involved will also be considered.

The student selected for the financial aid must use the money for their course of study expenses only (tuition, room, board and books.) Interested students should type or write an essay about his/her present plans for higher education including future career goals, as well as discuss their work experience, extracurricular activities and community involvement. Students must re-qualify each subsequent year for an additional \$1,000 award by completing a new application.

The Janice Southworth Memorial Scholarship Committee of the Quota Club of Lake County will make the selection of the student. This selection is based on the information given in the student's application, essay and letters of recommendations.

The completed 2023 application, the student's personal essay, and two letters of recommendation, along with a copy of his/her academic record should be mailed to the attention of Mrs. Deborah L. Lilly, 13311 Radcliffe Rd., Chardon, OH 44024. All application packets must be received by Friday, March 31, 2023. This is a new deadline for this scholarship. Please mail everything in the same envelope. Incomplete or late application packets will not be considered.

Janice Southworth was an officer of the Southworth Insurance Agency, Inc. as well as a teacher of cosmetology for eighteen years at Bedford High School. She obtained her college degree in education posthumously in August 1989, as she was tragically killed in an auto accident on the way to her last class needed for graduation from Kent State University. In 1969, she became a member of the club then known as Quota International of Lake County Inc., a service organization for professional executive business women dedicated to aiding individuals with impaired speech and hearing handicaps and assist disadvantaged women and children. It was from this association that she gained much personal satisfaction.

This scholarship is funded through memorial contributions and various fund raisers. Quota of Lake County Charitable Foundation aids with the fund raising of this program in Mrs. Southworth's memory. The scholarship is awarded every year at the beginning of May. Those students chosen receive a letter of congratulations from the Scholarship Committee. The scholarship is presented to the qualified student at a picnic in June.
