Meeting Minutes from March 13th, 2019

- The meeting was called to Order at 7:07 P.M.
- Pledge of Allegiance
- Cheryl motioned to approve Meeting Minutes from last month and Christina Brown seconded the motion. All present approved.
- Everyone who attended this month's meeting was entered into a door prize drawing for a \$25 Walmart giftcard. The giftcard was donated by Allison Esack. The winner was drawn at the end of the meeting by Ms. Kriegmont. This month's lucky winner was Leah Radabaugh.
- Carrie Blair thanked all of the recent volunteers for Art Show and Talent Show. She reported that this year's Nominating Committee will announce their slate of nominees for Treasurer, Secretary and Anchor at the end of the meeting. The new board members will take their post starting July 1st, and serve a two year term. The current board of officers decided to go back to having only one Treasurer position, and an Anchor position, for next term. So the five person board will be President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, and Anchor. We spoke about the year books, there were a total of 171 books sold as of last count. The end of yearbook pre-orders is March 15th, and then the books will be ordered.
- Ms. Kriegmont thanked all of the volunteers for their help with the Art Show and the Talent Show, both events were a success. There will be a fundraiser to benefit the levy campaign on April 8th at Grand River Winery. They are looking for donations of baked goods, if you are interested in baking please let a committee member know. You can drop the baked goods off at South Elementary the morning of the dinner, and Ms. Kriegmont will get them to the Winery. The levy committee will be planning two fundraisers every year to keep money in the account for upcoming levies. This levy on this May's ballot is a renewal levy, which will not increase the amount that is already paid by each homeowner. This renewal levy generates about \$700,000 a year for the Madison Local Schools. Ms. Kriegmont will have yard signs available soon. Our 'One School, One Book' program will be starting on April 2nd. The book has not yet been announced, but they were purchased. Every family will get one book to take home, and will be sent home with the oldest child in the family. The books cost about \$2300. Ms. Kriegmont and the PTA will split the cost of the books. The PTA will also buy a few more things for the program. Laurel announced that we purchased 700 bookmarks with our Scholastic Dollars for Ms. Kriegmont. We are unable to get the inspirational quote decals for the bathroom stalls. Marcy Hudson said they will not stick to our type of stall doors. Ms. Kriegmont and Sarah Drenik are looking at alternative

ideas of inspiration or kindness for that donation. Ms. Kriegmont shared that the school/district is looking for substitute aides and teachers. If you are interested, please let her know, and she will point you in the right direction.

- Spring BOGO Scholastic Book Fair is April 11th-17th during class library time for the students, and during Family Literacy Night on April 17th, from 6pm to 7:30pm. We will also have our Ice Cream Social during the event.
- Tiffany Green is chairing Teacher Appreciation Week this year, and gave a written report to Carrie Blair to share her plans for the week.
- Fundraising – Chocolate sales totaled \$5965, and we should be profiting 35% of that total. Chocolate orders can be picked up on April 10th in the cafeteria from 6-7:30 pm, or on April 17th from 6-7:30 pm during Literacy Night/Ice Cream Social. If a parent wants to pick up their chocolate order during pickup at 2pm (between 4/10 & 4/17), please contact Cheryl Radovan. We sold a few more DQ discount cards during Parent-Teacher Conferences, so the total profit for our DQ Discount Cards is \$410. Our Delightful Soy Candle fundraiser begins March 22nd, and orders will be received until April 12th. The candle orders will be available to pick up on Friday, April 26th, at the school. We are excited about the chosen scents this time, which include Coffee, Margarita, Lemongrass Sage, Snickerdoodle, Lemon.
