

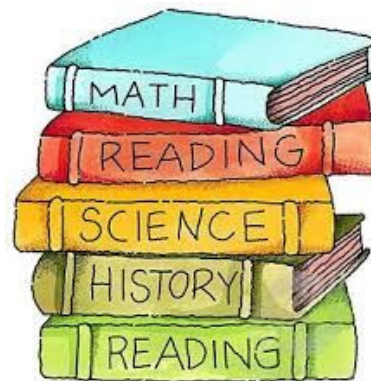

GUIDANCE WEBSITE

SCHEDULE CHANGE GUIDELINES



ACCEPTABLE:

- Wrong grade level course
- Missing a core class
- Athletic Eligibility-
2.5 credits per semester

NOT ACCEPTABLE:

- Teacher preference
- Decided not to take a class
- Dropping a core class

CREDIT REQUIREMENTS



- Refer to the course guide booklet to utilize the credit tracking table. The credit tracking table outlines the all of the credits required for graduation.
- If you are unsure about the credits you have already earned, please refer to the transcript that can be found in Infinite Campus- student portal .
- Failed classes can be requested again. Senior year you can remediate your failed classes online if necessary.

LOG INTO INFINITE CAMPUS



- Parent/Student Portal
- Use your own login and password
- Username = Student ID: Username: 196xxxxxx
(The student ID number that starts with 195 or 196)
- Password = Password: first initial, middle initial, last initial and student birthday mmddyy (ALL LOWERCASE)

“HOW-TO” SCHEDULE

1. Madison Local Schools Website
2. Infinite Campus- Student Portal
3. Login (refer to previous slide for instructions)
4. Click “Academic Planner” & “Next” (NEW this year)
 - Columns= Grade Level 9, 10, 11 & 12
 - Rows= Subject Area (English, Math, Science, Social Studies, etc.)
5. Click on each blank field for the course offerings
 - Ex: Click the English field to select your English class



6. **CLICK SAVE** as you work!!!!
7. Only enter requests for next school year!!!!
 - *ALWAYS select 10 credits (total credits display at the top of the column)
 - *2.5 credits for eligibility
 - *Follow credit requirements for graduation

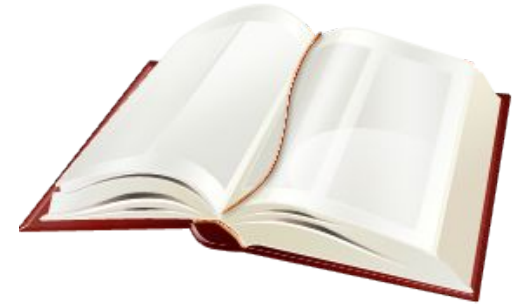

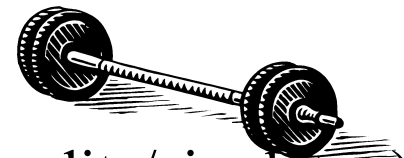


HEALTH & PHYSICAL EDUCATION

- Lifetime Sports (.25 credits/singleton)
- Personal Fitness Walk/Jog/Fitness Center (.25credits/singleton)
- Beginning weight Training (.25 credits/singleton)
- Adv. Weight Training (.5 credits/block) ATHLETES ONLY!



PE Waiver: 2 seasons of a sport, 2 years of Band or Show Choir
Do not register for any PE courses if you plan to do the waiver

FINE ART



- Art 1 (.5 credit)
- Art 2, 3, 4, & 5 (see descriptions of each in course guide)
- Drama (.5 credit)
- Concert Choir A & B
- Women's Choir A & B- audition required!
- Show Choir A & B -audition required!
- Marching Band A & B - audition required!
- Jazz Band A & B - audition required!



FOREIGN LANGUAGE



- Spanish 1, 2, 3, 4
 - NOT needed for graduation
 - 3 years are needed for an Honors Diploma
 - Colleges like to see 2 or more years

ATHLETIC ELIGIBILITY

- Be sure you are passing **2.5 credits each semester** in order to be eligible to play sports.
- This means you need at least 2 block classes and a .5 credit singleton (PE = .25!) each semester.

*It is **your responsibility** to check your eligibility!*
